Animism is a way of approaching life that emphasizes relationships. Animists see the world as full of persons, both human and other-than-human (e.g. plants, animals, fungi, mountains, metals, fire, bodies of water, spirits of wind and weather, deities, human ancestors) and prioritize living in respectful ways with them.

Animism gets at what people often mean when expressing a draw to indigenous traditions or shamanism-- in ways that avoid some pitfalls of those terms. Participants will learn how to solidly anchor rituals they create (or already practice) in core animist values.

Course Includes:

- Over 7 hours of video instruction with guided experiential exercises
- Option to download accompanying audio files of course content
- Opportunity to engage in course participant discussion space
- Invitation during course to ask Dr. Foor directly for support with the material
- Ongoing access to accompanying readings



Daniel Foor, PhD, is a licensed psychotherapist, doctor of psychology and author of *Ancestral Medicine: Rituals for Personal and Family Healing*. Since 2003, he has guided hundreds of days of outdoor ritual working with diverse spirits of place, first in the S.F. Bay Area and now in Western North Carolina. He is a Wilderness First Responder, amateur naturalist, and devotee of this specific precious Earth. He has been blessed to live as a student of culture in the Czech Republic, Mexico, Ecuador, Egypt, Morocco, and Nigeria. Daniel is an initiate in the Ifá/Òriṣà tradition of Yoruba-speaking West Africa and has trained with teachers of Mahayana Buddhism, Islamic Sufism, and different indigenous paths, including the older ways of his European ancestors. He lives in Asheville, NC.
